



Update 18: 18th March 2010



1. The Members of the Trust were asked to give instruction to the directors about whether to proceed with the Atlantic Islands Centre.
2. Ballot papers were sent to all Members with voting rights as of the Members' list at 1st March 2010, for return by 17th March, by post, or at the Members' meeting.
3. A General Meeting of Members was held in Cullipool Hall on Wednesday 17 March to discuss the future of the Centre and afterwards the final votes were cast.
4. The Company Secretary, acting as Returning Officer, observed two Members who counted the votes.
5. The votes cast were as follows (with percentages of votes cast)
 - for the motion to proceed with the project 63 91.3%
 - against the motion to proceed with the project 3 4.3%
 - registered abstentions 3 4.3%
6. There are 77 members as at 1st March 2010 made up of 66 residents, of whom 62 voted, and 11 non-resident property owners, of whom 7 voted i.e. 90% of Members voted, and only 8 Members did not respond.
7. The motion was carried by an overwhelming majority, as a result of which the directors will now take the project forward.
